Insults and mockery: Mean messages that hurt the victim.


School bullying spreading online: Rumors or humiliations from other students.

Sexual harassment: Sending inappropriate sexual messages or images.


Today, we will follow Fatoumata, Malik, Aïsha, and Kuame, four friends, to understand how to prevent and respond to cyberbullying.


