Cyberbullying happens when someone is insulted, threatened, or humiliated online — whether on a social network, an online game, a forum, or a private message. It can take different forms:

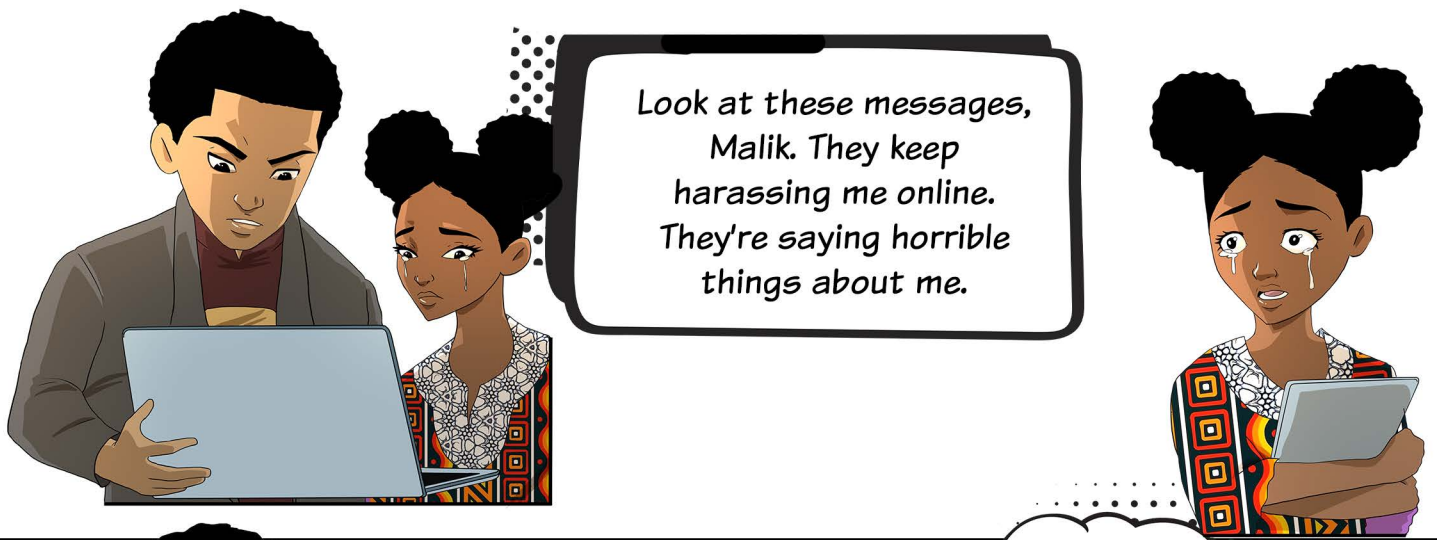
Insults and mockery: Mean messages that hurt the victim.

School bullying spreading online: Rumors or humiliations from other students.

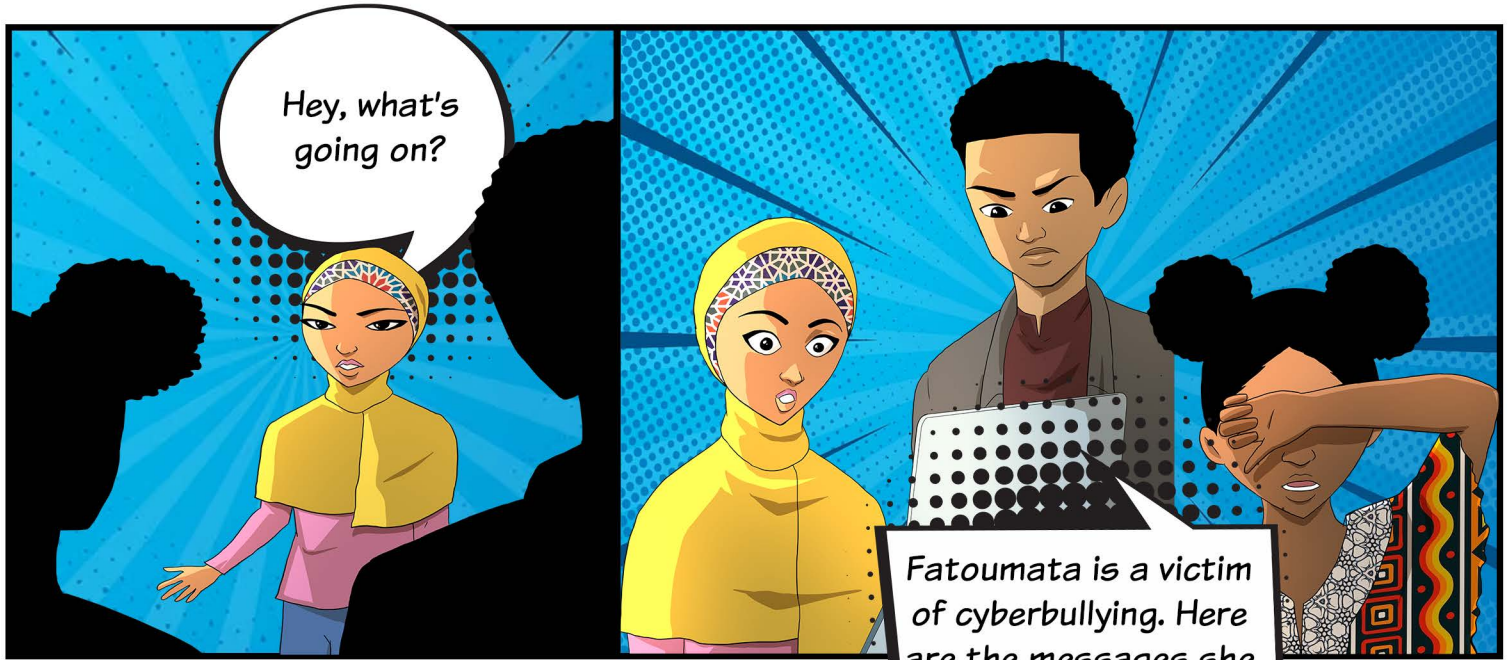
Sexual harassment: Sending inappropriate sexual messages or images.

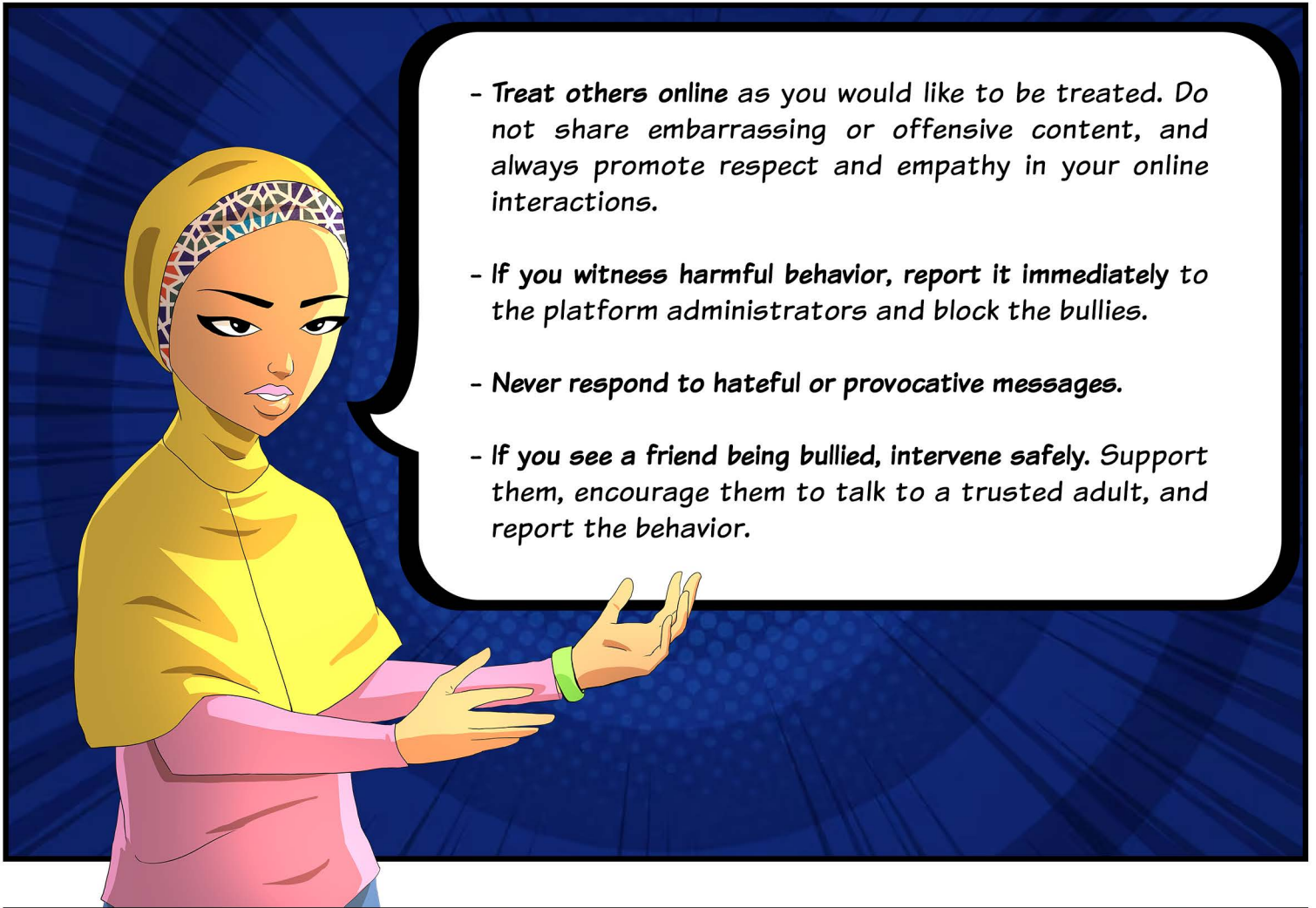
Next, we'll report this behavior on the relevant platforms and block the bullies. We should also inform our teachers so they can be aware and help you.

Raising Awareness



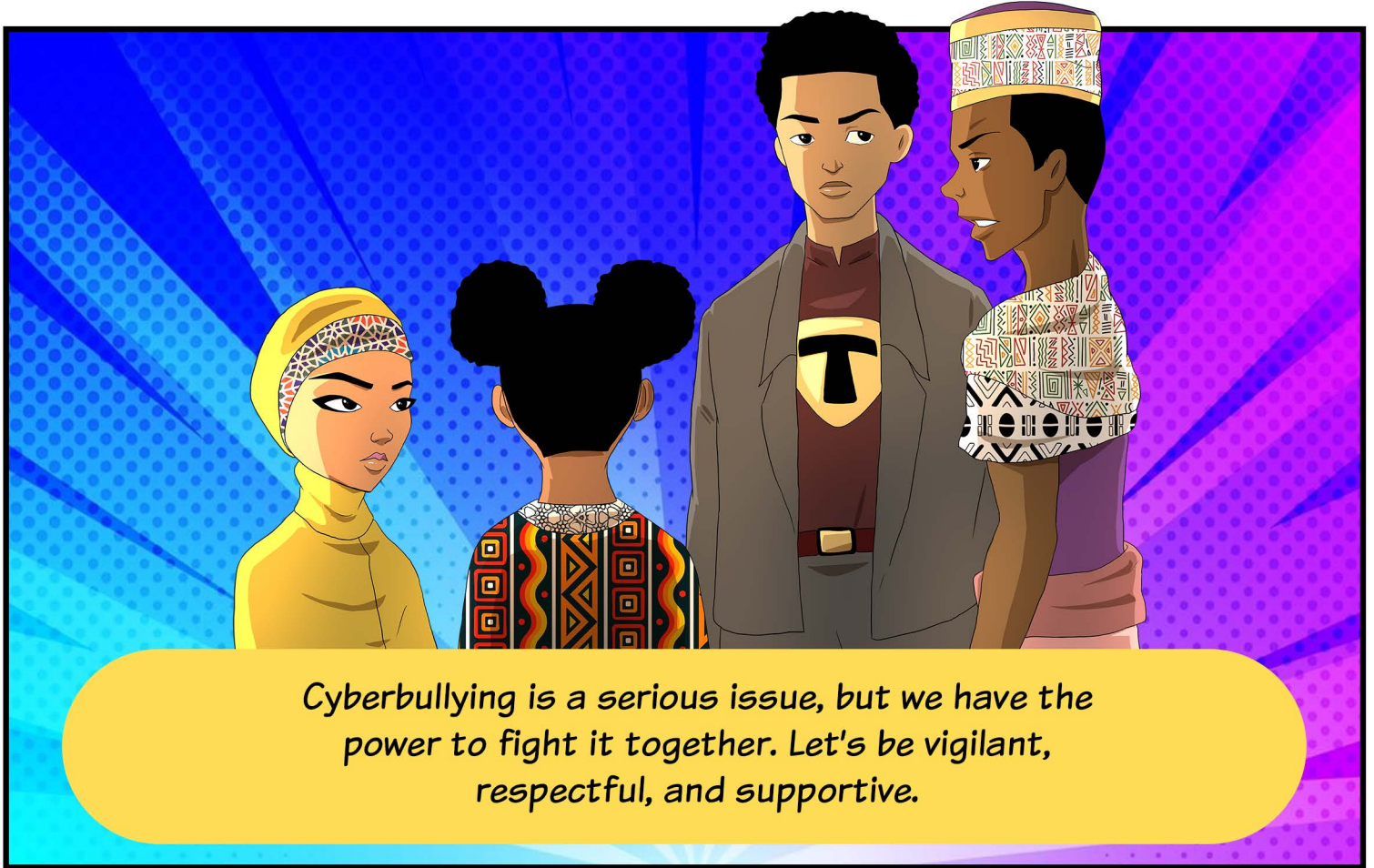


- *Treat others online as you would like to be treated. Do not share embarrassing or offensive content, and always promote respect and empathy in your online interactions.*
- *If you witness harmful behavior, report it immediately to the platform administrators and block the bullies.*
- *Never respond to hateful or provocative messages.*
- *If you see a friend being bullied, intervene safely. Support them, encourage them to talk to a trusted adult, and report the behavior.*

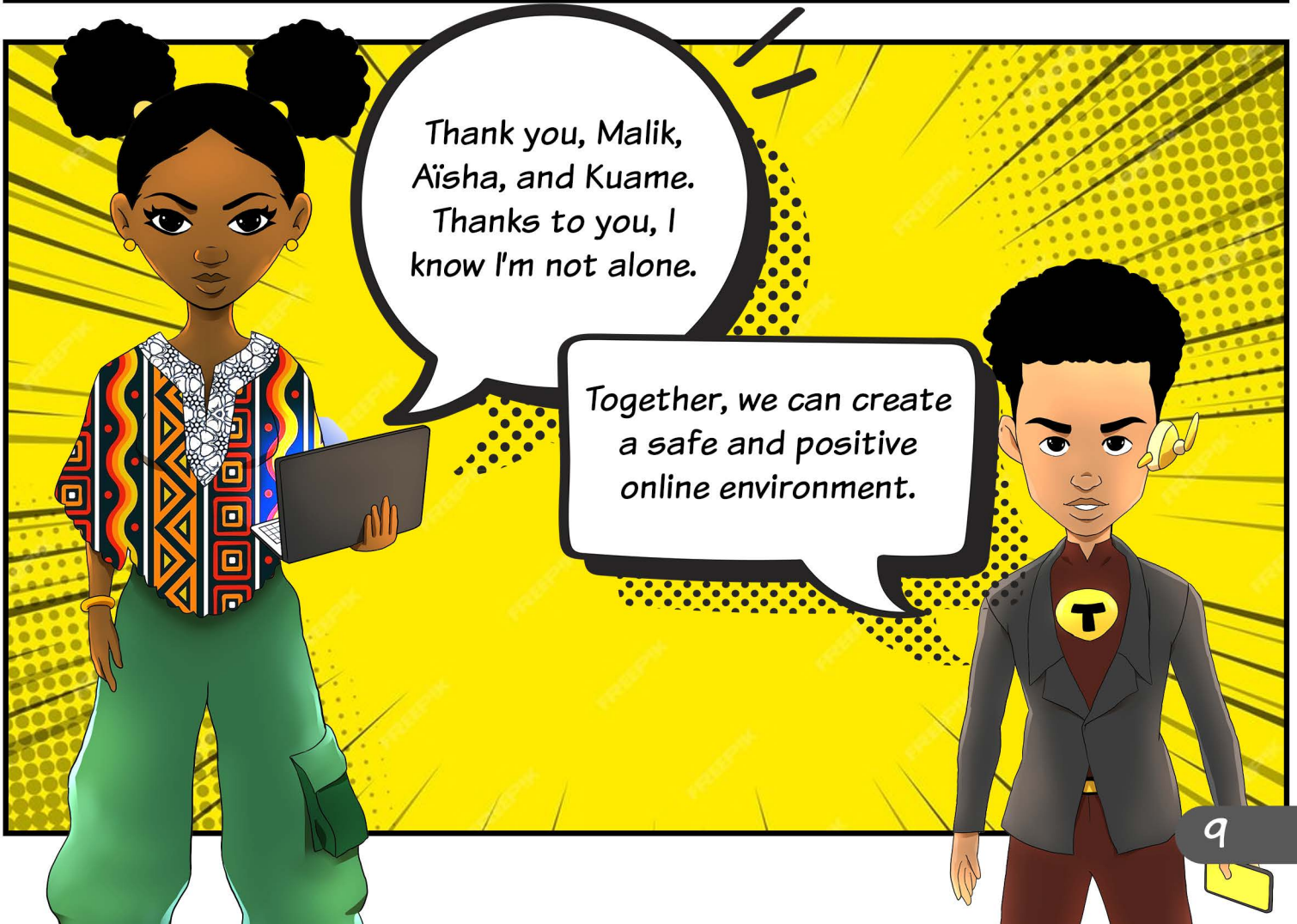


And most importantly, if you are a victim, talk to a trusted adult. Together, we can fight cyberbullying.

Cyberbullying is a serious issue, but we have the power to fight it together. Let's be vigilant, respectful, and supportive.



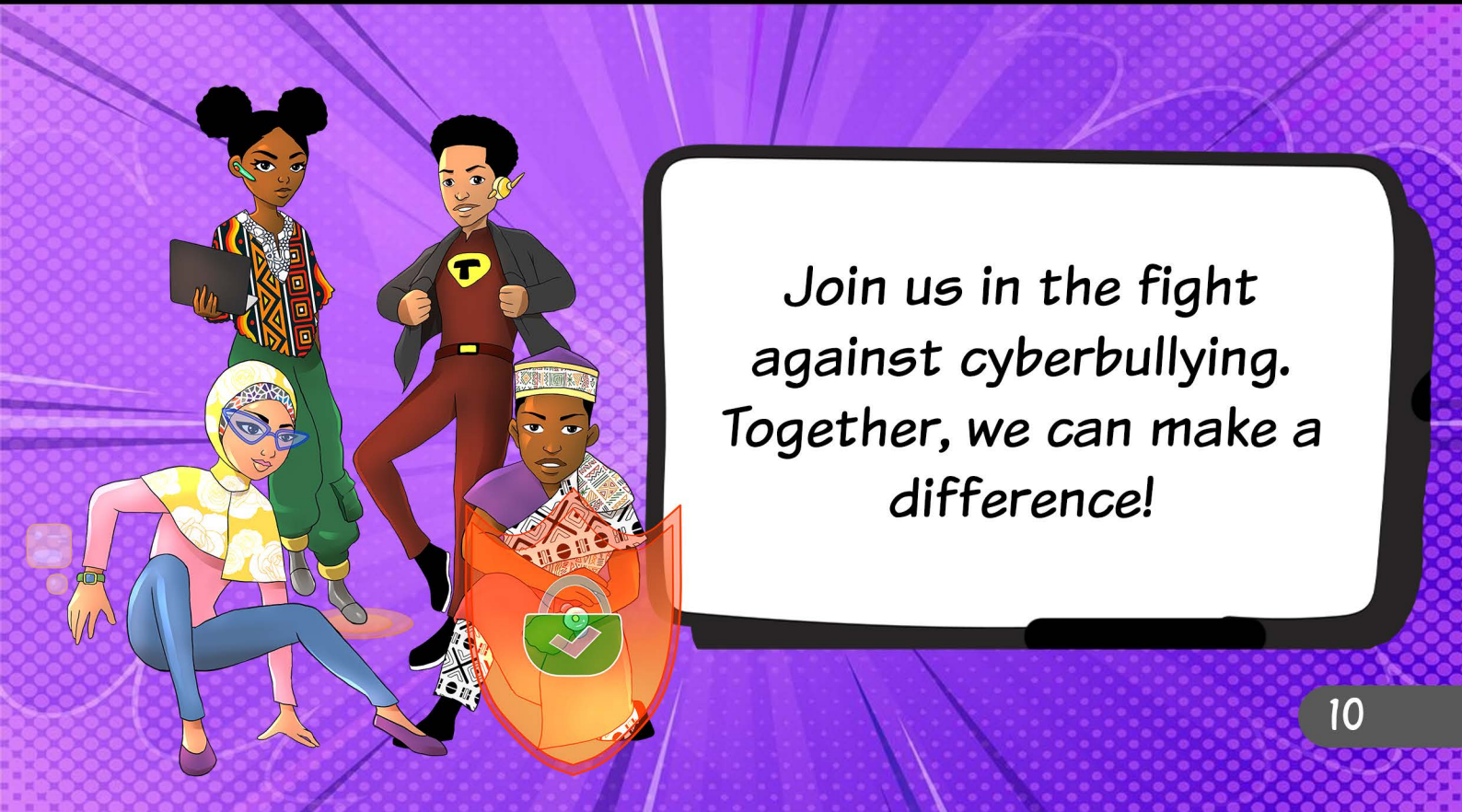
